

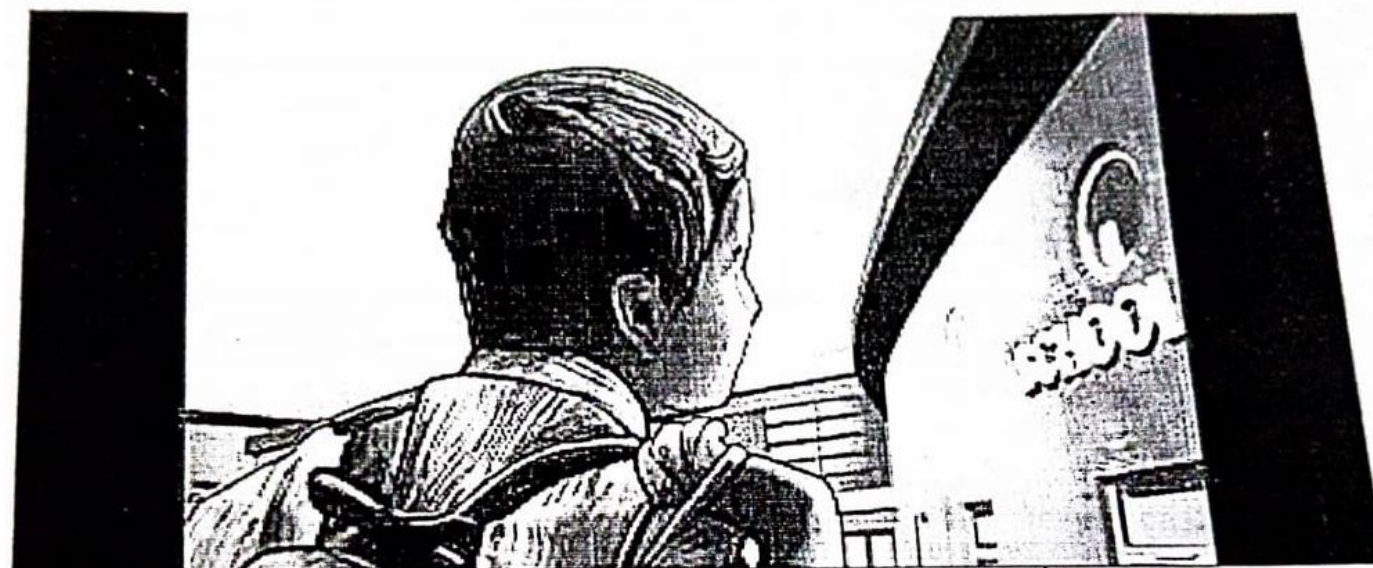

➤ Playing fields & libraries after normal school hours & during holidays

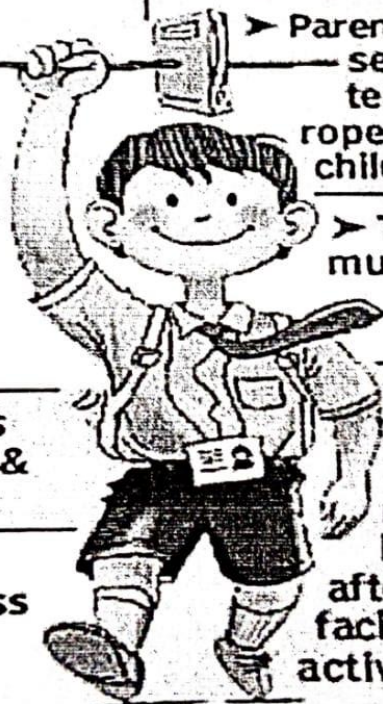
Eco-clubs are meant for the promotion of awareness in environment, climate, local ecology, nutrition,

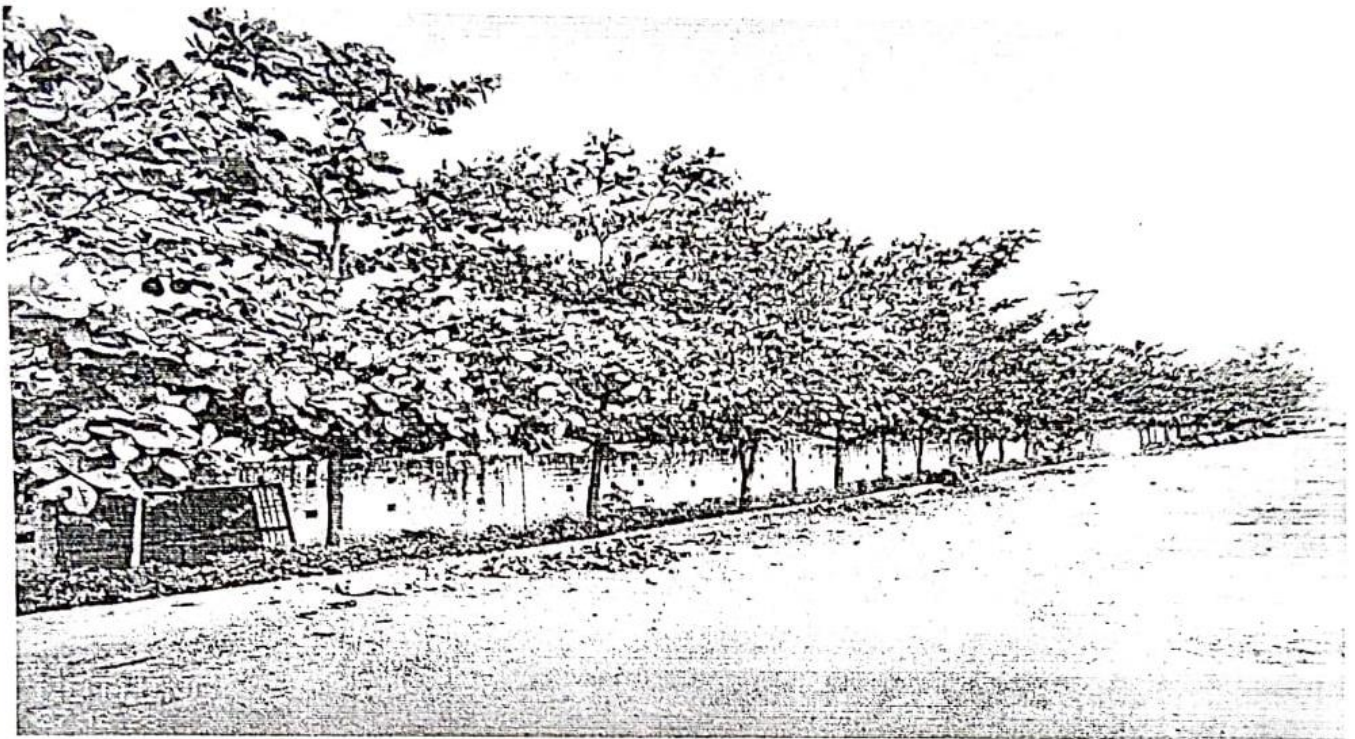
